## **Introduction**

World Environment Day is observed on June 5th every year to promote environmental awareness and encourage action for the protection of nature. In accordance with this objective and the principles of Ayurveda, the Department of Dravyaguna and Agada Tantra organized an awareness programme focusing on environmental conservation and its impact on human health.

Ayurveda recognizes the close relationship between the environment, medicinal plants, and human well-being. Dravyaguna emphasizes the importance of medicinal plant conservation, while Agada Tantra highlights the role of environmental toxins (*Visha*) in disease causation. The programme aimed to integrate these concepts through awareness and practical activity.

## **Objectives of the Programme**

1. To create awareness about environmental protection on World Environment Day.
2. To highlight the importance of medicinal plants and biodiversity as explained in Dravyaguna.
3. To educate participants on environmental toxins and pollution from the Agada Tantra perspective.
4. To promote eco-friendly afforestation through seed ball preparation.
5. To encourage sustainable and nature-friendly practices among students.

## **Programme Details**

The programme began with an awareness talk on the significance of World Environment Day and the relevance of environmental health in Ayurveda. Faculty members discussed the role of medicinal plants in maintaining ecological balance and the impact of environmental pollution, pesticides, and toxins on human health.

Special emphasis was laid on:

- Conservation of medicinal plants (*Aushadhi Dravya Rakshana*)
- Environmental pollution as a source of *Dooshi Visha*
- Preventive measures through sustainable living

This was followed by a **hands-on seed ball preparation session**, where students actively participated in preparing seed balls using soil, organic manure, and seeds of native and medicinal plants. The importance of using indigenous plant species for environmental restoration was explained.

- Undergraduate and postgraduate students
- Faculty members
- Interns and non-teaching staff

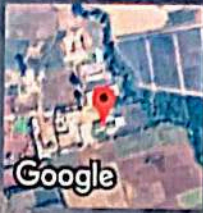
### Outcome of the Programme

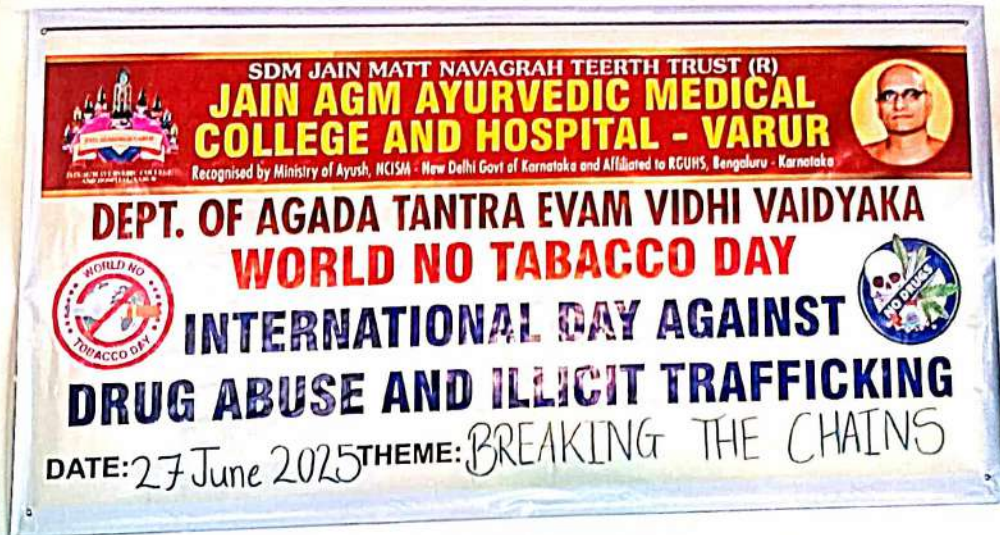

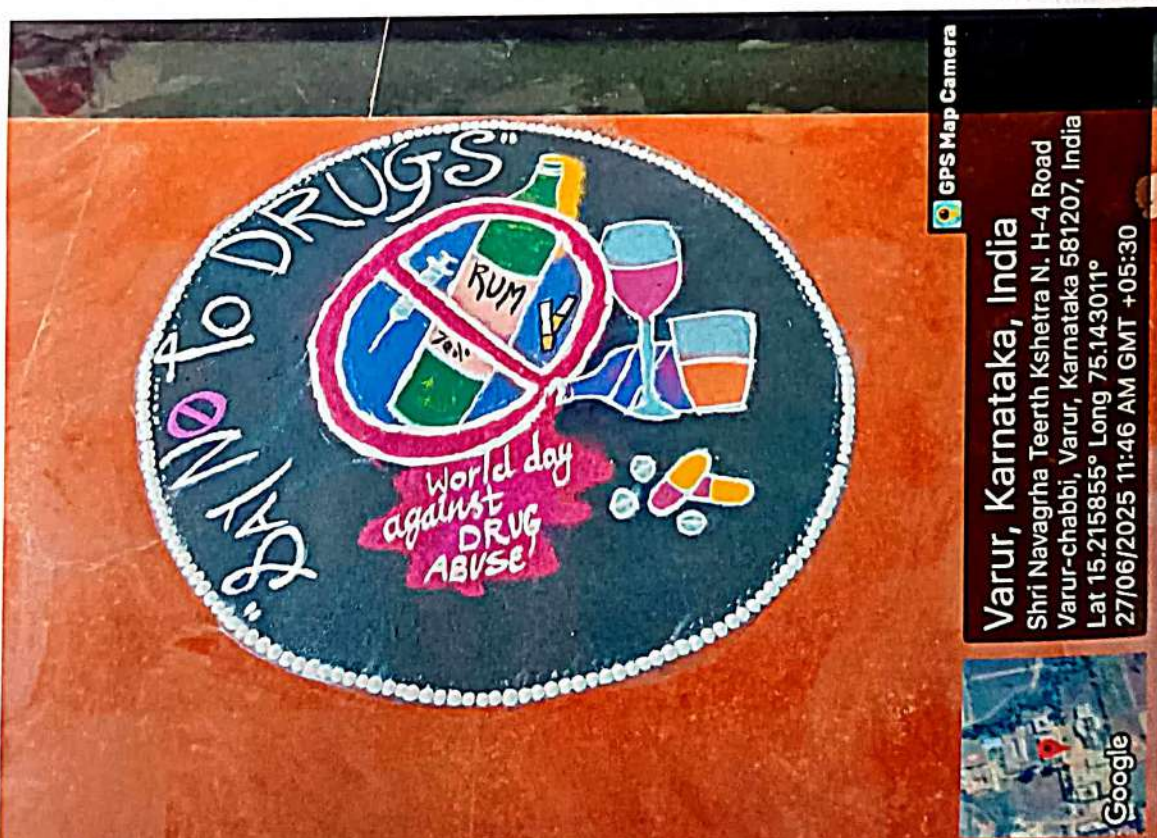

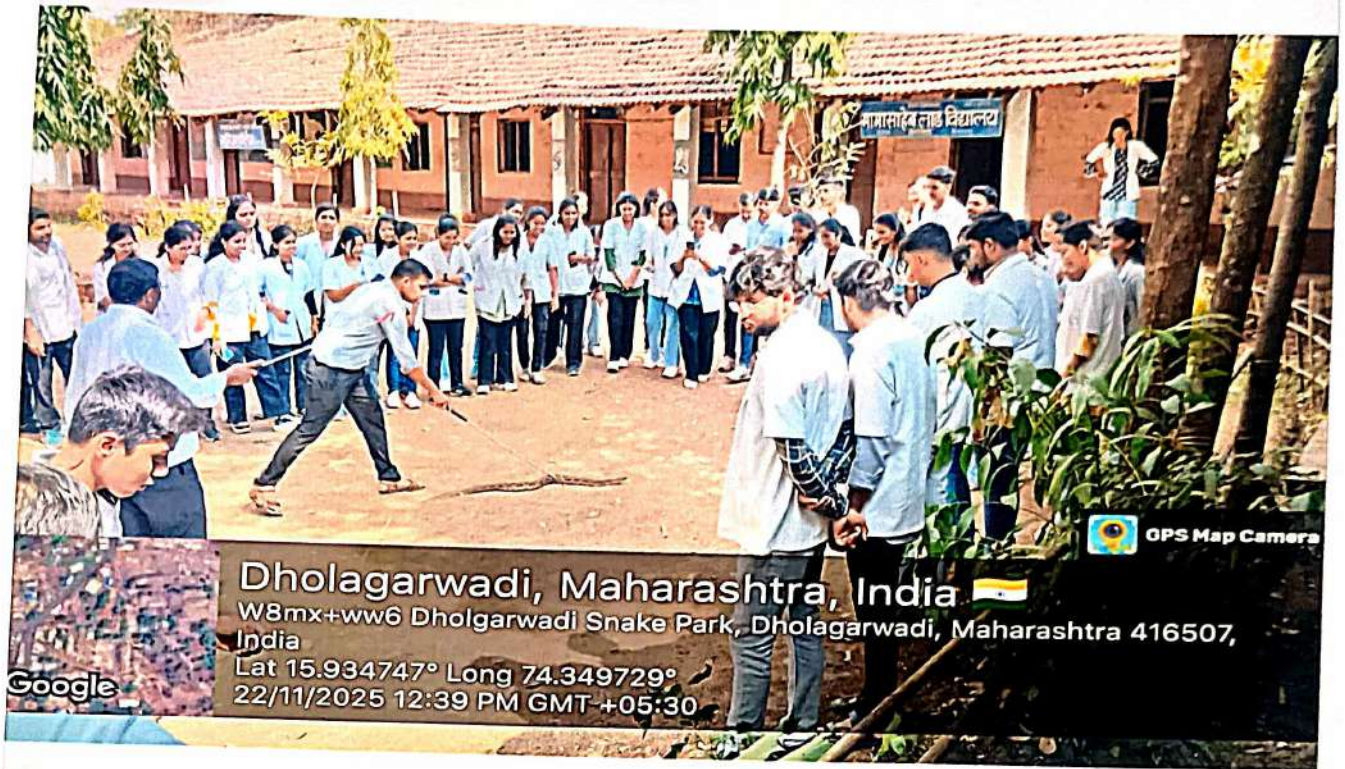
