PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "**MOU**") is made and entered into on this **4th day of July 2025**.

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation between the parties. If the dispute remains unresolved, it shall be referred to arbitration as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

GOVERNING LAW

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India.





ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES



THE ORGANISATION agrees to:

1. Design, develop, and deliver comprehensive development programs for faculty and students as per the needs of THE COLLEGE.
2. Provide qualified and experienced resource persons/trainers for conducting the programs.
3. Prepare and distribute necessary training materials for the programs.
4. Conduct periodic assessments to evaluate the effectiveness of the programs.
5. Provide certificates of participation/completion to the participants.
6. Submit a detailed report after the completion of each program.

THE COLLEGE agrees to:

1. Provide necessary infrastructure including venue, audio-visual equipment, and other facilities required for conducting the programs.
2. Ensure participation of faculty members and students as per the agreed schedule.
3. Provide administrative support for the smooth conduct of the programs.
4. Facilitate feedback collection from participants.
5. Provide accommodation and local hospitality for trainers, if required.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. The financial arrangements for each program shall be mutually decided and agreed upon in writing before the commencement of the program.
2. THE COLLEGE shall pay THE ORGANISATION the agreed fee for each program within 30 days of completion of the program and submission of invoice.
3. All payments shall be made through cheque/bank transfer to the account specified by THE ORGANISATION.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

All intellectual property developed jointly during the collaboration shall be jointly owned by both parties. Neither party shall use the other's name, logo, or other intellectual property without prior written consent.

DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years.
2. This MOU may be renewed by mutual written consent of both parties.
3. Either party may terminate this MOU by giving three (3) months written notice to the other party.
4. Termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any ongoing program.
