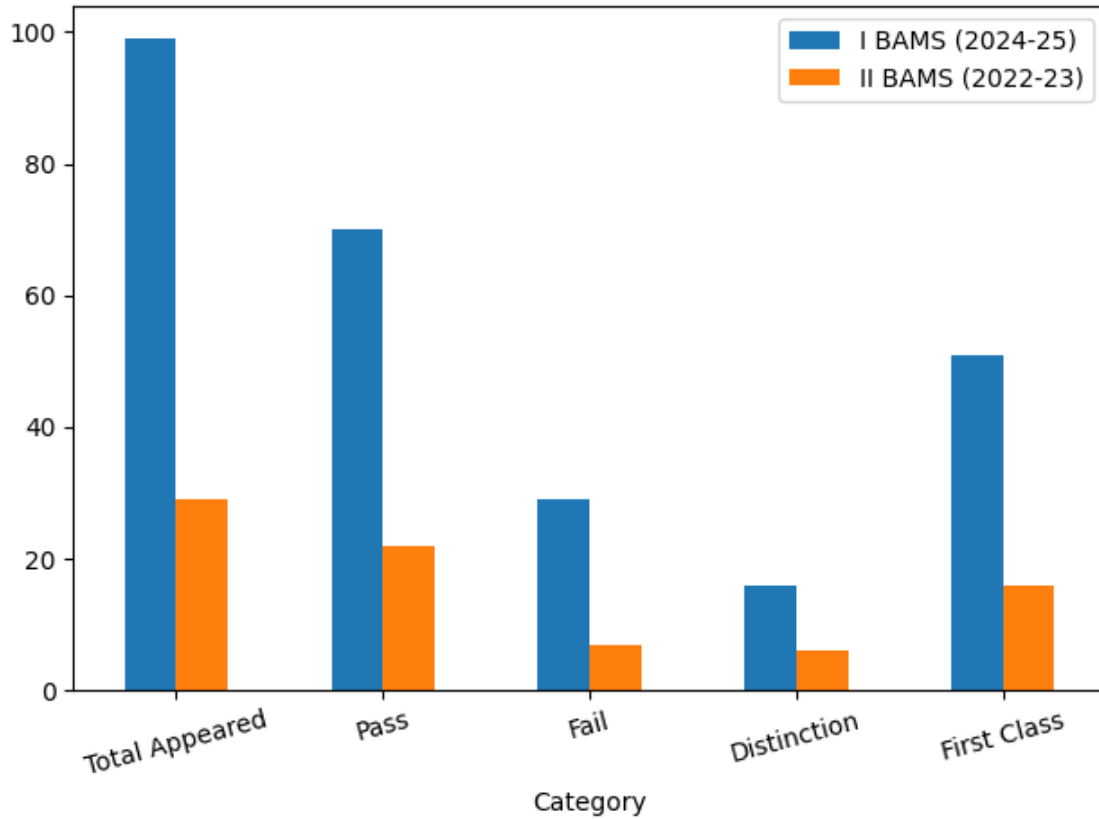
### Comparative Analysis of BAMS Results of Exams Conducted in March 2026 by RGUHS for 1<sup>st</sup> Yr BAMS (2024-25 Batch) & 2<sup>nd</sup> Yr BAMS (2022-23 Batch)

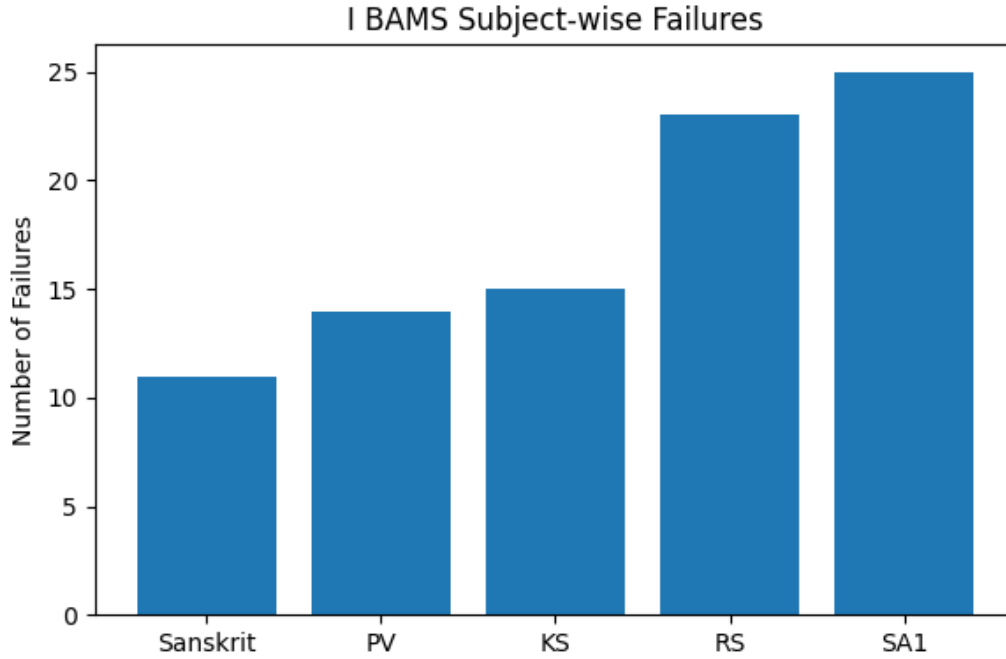
#### Comparative Summary

Category	I BAMS	II BAMS
Total Appeared	99	29
Pass	70	22
Fail	29	7
Distinction	16	6
First Class	51	16



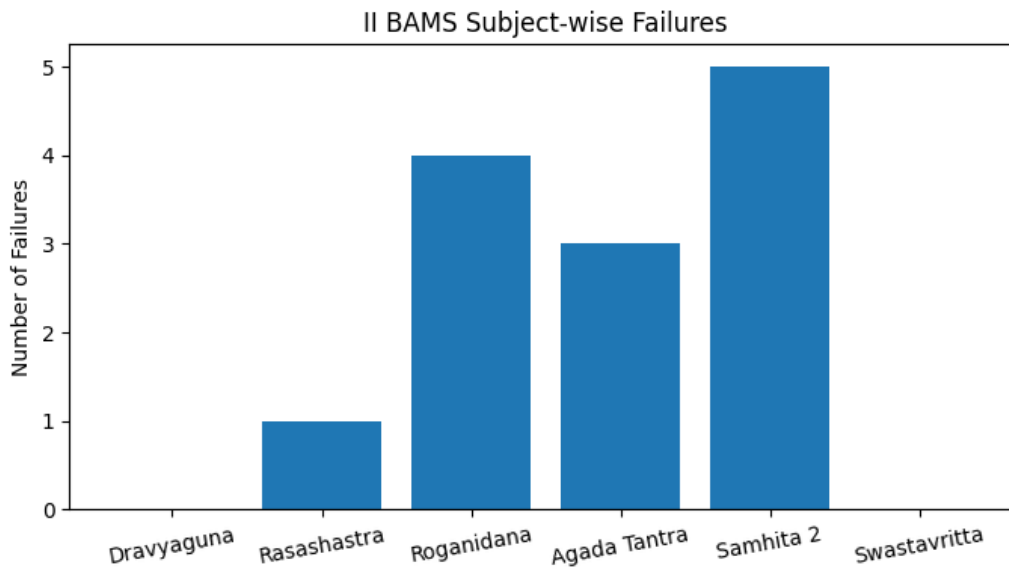
### I BAMS Analysis (2024-25 Batch)

- Total students appeared: 99
- Pass percentage: 70.7%
- Fail percentage: 29.3%
- Highest number of failures were seen in SA1 and RS.
- Distinction holders: 16
- First Class: 51



### II BAMS Analysis (2022-23 Batch)

- Total students appeared: 29
- Pass percentage: 75.9%
- Fail percentage: 24.1%
- Highest number of failures were observed in Samhita-2 and Roganidana.
- Distinction holders: 6
- First Class: 16



### **Key Comparative Observations**

1. The II BAMS batch demonstrated a slightly higher pass percentage compared to the I BAMS batch.
2. I BAMS showed comparatively higher subject-wise failures, especially in SA1 and RS.
3. Both batches recorded a strong proportion of First Class results.
4. Academic reinforcement may be particularly beneficial in subjects with consistently higher failure rates.
